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WOMEN'S RE-DRESSAL CELL

Introduction:

The Women Grievance and Redressal Cell has been constituted to maintain safety and security of the girls and women of the institute. The Cell deals with the cases / complaints of sexual harassment and any other type of harassment of the female students, teaching and non-teaching women staff of the institute. If the students or female employees face any harassment, then they can complain at women grievance and redressal cell. The members will look into the issues, gather the evidence, and take the necessary action against the guilty. The Cell is vigilant and keeps a keen eye on the entire campus.

In agreement with the Ultimate Court Decision and Strategies delievered in 1997 to deliever for the operative administration of the simple moral right of gender equality and agreement beside sesual persedution and misuse, more mostly touching erotic irritation at efforts eats the University Grants Commission (UGC) has delievered circulars since 1998 and maintaining the portrayal of the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Avoidance, Exclusion and Redressal Act- Erotic Pestering Act in April 2013) to all the universities, counseling them to found a stable cell and to casing strategies to struggle erotic annoyance, strength beside women and teasing at the universities and colleges.

The ICC (SH) is committed to:

Objective of the Women's Grievance Redressal Cell:

- e) The Cell shall process all the individual complaints and take immediate suitable action.
- f) The Cell will provide assistance to the Faculty/Colleges for taking preventive steps in the matter of gender discrimination and sexual harassment.
- g) The Prinicpal will be the Chairman of the Cell and may appoint members of the cell.
- h) The Cell may form/review the guidelines/policy for Redressal of the grievance as required from time to time, which may be in accordance with those issued by Supereme Court and Government Agencies.
- i) To organize programs and activities for women empowerment, health and hygiene.

The Nature of the Activities of the Cell:

The laws on Sexul Harassment the Supreme Court, which regards sexual harassment as a yielation of human rights and as a form of systematic discrimination against women, has issued guidelines to prevent, as well as punish, perpetrators of sexual harassment. It is legally mandatory for employers and administrators to deploy measures for combating and redressing incidents of sexual harassment in their organizations. The committee is set to deal with instances of sexual harassment within its precints has decided that aggrieved women send their complaints to it by post or email

Sexual Harassment-Definition:

According to the Supreme Court, Sexual Harassment is defined as "unwelcome sexually determined behaviour" such as :

- a) Physical contact, and making advanced.
- b) A demand or request for sexual favours.
- c) Sexually oriented remarks.
- d) Showing pornography.
- e) Use of electronic media (phone, internet, intranet) for perpetrating any of the above.
- f) Any other unwelcome physical, verbal, or non-verbal conduct of a sexual nature.

Grievance Procedure:

- a) Any women employee or female student will have the right to lodge a complaint concerning sexual harassment against a male student or the employee of the institute by writing a letter or putting the complaint in the Prinicpal's office.
- b) The complaint will be afforded full confidentiality at this stage.
- c) After receiving the complaint, the chairman shall convene the meeting of the cell.
- d) The chairman will appoint investigation committee, Coordinator will convene the meetings.
- e) The investigation committee shall then decide the course of action to proceed.
- f) The complaint will stand dropped if in accordance to the committee the complaint has not been able to disclose prima-facie an offence of sexual harassment by complainer/her representative.
- g) In case the investigation committee decides to proceed with the complaint, the wishes of the complainer shall be ascertained and if the complainer wishes that a warning will suffice then alleged offender shall be called to the meeting of the committee, heard and if satisfied that a warning is just and proper, here will be warned about his behaviour and non-occurrence of it. In case the complainer requests that the complaint should be proceeded with beyond mere a warning, the same may be proceeded with in the manner prescribed here after.

Procedure for investigation:

- a) If the complainer wishes to proceed beyond a mere a warning to the accused, the accused shall be given in writing by enquiry committee an opportunity to explain within one week way he should not be, for good and sufficient reasons, be punished for the act of sexual harassment on his part.
- b) If the written description of the indicted is not found to be satisfactory or if he does not provide any written explanation, the investigation committee will decide whether the offence deserves a minor penalty or a major penalty.
- c) In the event that the investigation committee deciding that the accused be forced a minor penalty, the said penalty will be recommended by the investigation committee to the chairman of the cell for decision.
- d) If the investigation committee comes to a conclusion that the accused in case if his guit proved, should be imposed a major penalty, it shall make a recommendation of action. If the accused is an employee, he may be placed under suspension under the provisions of act.

e) If a person is charged with physical molestation or rape on college/society's premises the state immediately placed under suspension pending the completion of the investigation and emptire Appropriate action can be initiated as per the laws of Indian penal code.

Punishment for Sexual Harassment:

- a) Any member of the : Organization community (student/employee/outsider related to institute) found guilty of sexual harassment shall be liable to be punished. This shall be subject to the same penalties for major or minor misbehaviour as prescribed under government/university rules.
- b) Warning or reprimand.
- c) Suspension from university/ college for a period of one month.
- d) Debarment from appearing for the esamination for period up to three years.
- e) Rustication from the university as the case may be.
- f) Any other punishment as defined by the government/ university act.

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
