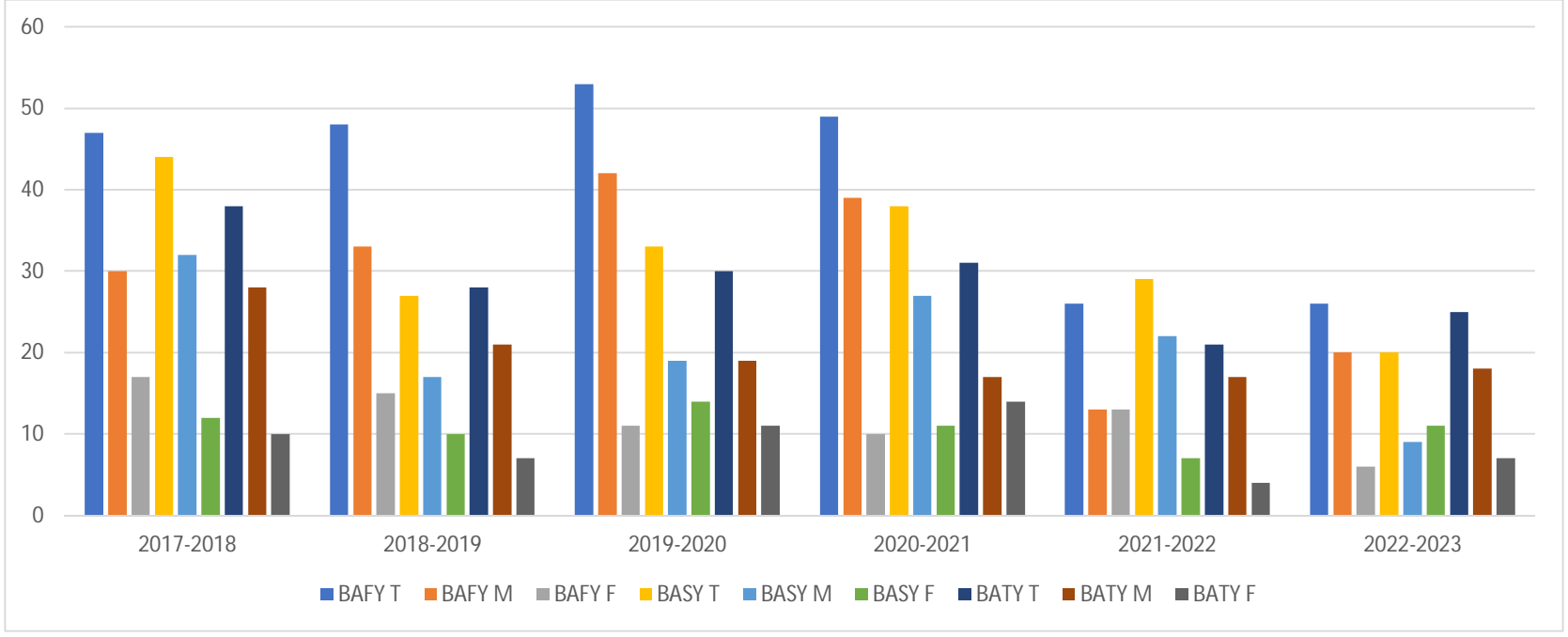

Graph of Gender-wise Distribution of the Student

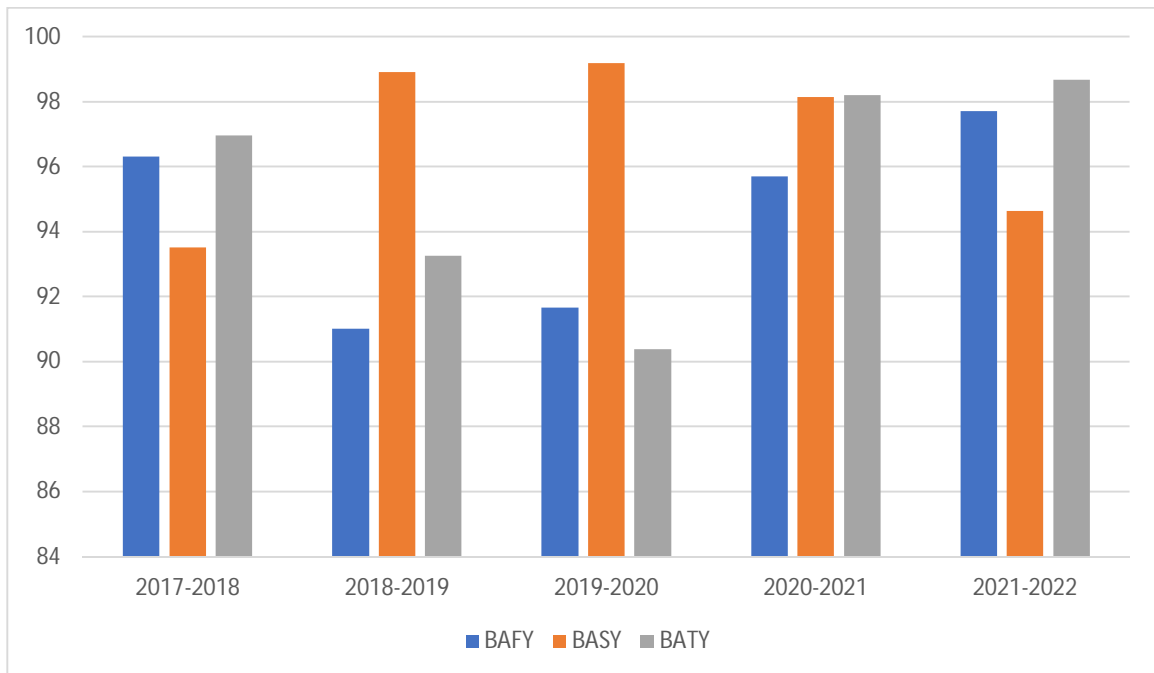

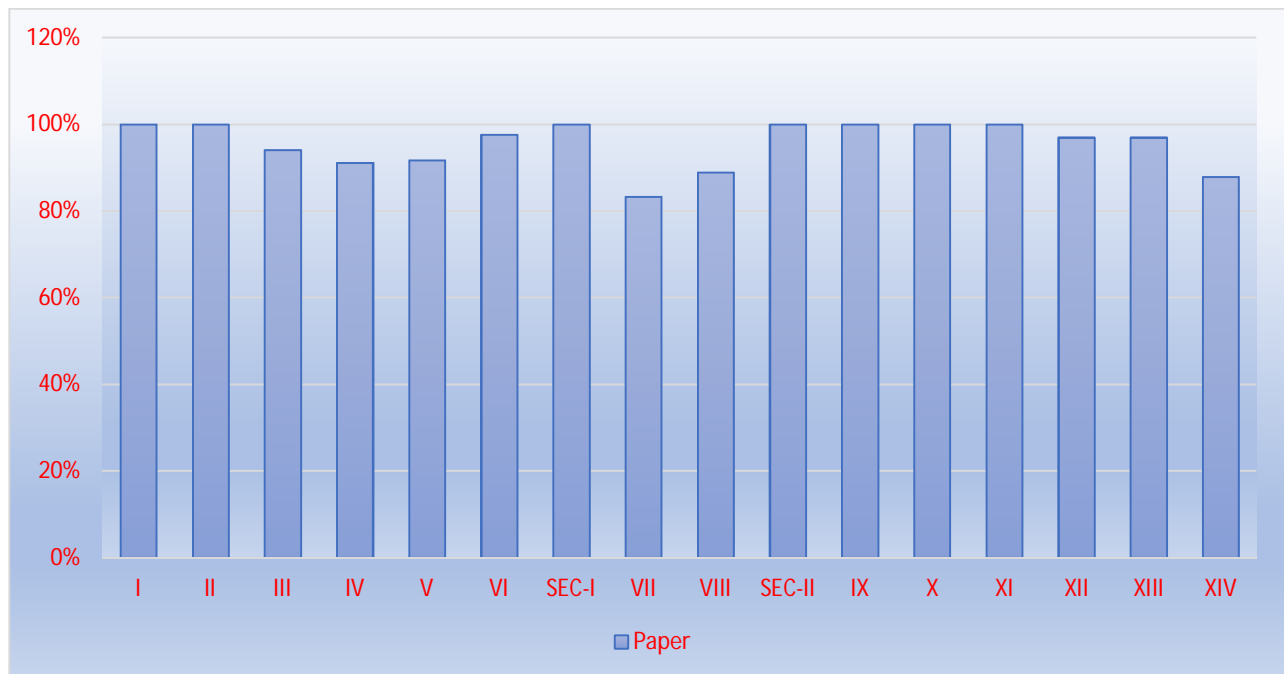
Graph of Results of the Department
